SAVE OUR PHARMACY IN NEW POND PARADE



Many residents may have seen or even signed the petition to prevent the closure of Nu-Ways Pharmacy which is at the heart of the community for many residents close to New Pond Parade. Nu-Ways has been identified by NHS England as no longer in need of 'essential small pharmacy support'.

As councillors, together with Boris Johnson, our MP, we are looking at ways to prevent this having an adverse impact on what is an important part of our community.

Cllr Susan O'Brien said "The nearest pharmacy is just under one mile away, which is just too far for those who do not drive or require a more personal service or regular contact with their pharmacist."
